YOUR RIGHTS AGAINST DISCRIMINATION

TITLE VI

OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 provides that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

The Public Works Department of Cathedral City administers its programs and activities without regard to race, color, national origin, or other protected status. The Public Works Department prohibits discrimination by employees, contractors, and anyone who acts on behalf of the city. Any person who believes that they have been discriminated against may file a written complaint with the City of Cathedral City Public Works Department Title Vi Coordinator, within 180 days of the alleged discrimination.
