  1. VCALM Radar Signs: Staff updated Commission on demo VCALM Radar Speed Sign currently running at Cathedral Canyon & 33<sup>rd</sup> Ave.; also discussing potential multiple VCALM installations in the City with upcoming grant opportunities (100% outside funding). The demo VCALM may be purchased by the City.
  2. Joint Planning and S&T Commissions Workshop (Date Palm Study) 6/16/10: Discussed comments at mtg.
  3. Development Projects: Distributed status update (Dev. Projects by Community Development Dir.) 4 pgs.
  4. Roundabouts & Traffic Circles in future CC roadways?: Commissioner Glowitz provided a 2<sup>nd</sup> pro/con presentation update (FHWA report distributed). Full Commission to discuss at 8/26/10 mtg. for consensus.
  5. Widening East Palm Canyon to 6 Lanes (Status): Measure A funding request to CVAG, to be reviewed by CVAG subcommittees (Valley-wide Regional Roadways), then to CVAG Executive Committee in fall 2010.
