- I. **ROLL CALL:** Present: Commissioners: Baker, Navarro, and Sands.

- II. **APPROVAL OF ABSENCES:** Commissioners Glowitz & Malachowsky had meeting conflicts out of town.
Motion: Sands, Second: Baker, the Commission approved the two absences.
- III. **APPROVAL OF COMMISSION MINUTES:** (March 25, 2010 Meeting)
March 25 meeting minutes were deferred to next meeting due to lack of quorum (Sands not present 3/25).

- IV. **PUBLIC COMMENTS:** (no public in attendance)
- V. **NEW BUSINESS:**
 1. VCALM Radar Sign Demo Briefing: Staff explained the demo running at Cathedral Canyon and 33rd Ave. (Supplier: Fortel Traffic, Inc.) Commissioners Navarro and Glowitz attended a briefing to staff and CCPD officers by Fortel on May 25th. Staff also indicated intent to apply for Safe Routes to School Grant (SR2S) program funds, using Fortel as grant writer. The VCALM Radar Sign has significantly reduced speeding on northbound Cathedral Canyon, and is supported by CCPD Traffic Division officers. The Commission recommended to Council that staff apply for grants to assist in expanding the program in the City.
 2. Joint Planning and Streets & Transportation Commission (DATE PALM DRIVE) Workshop: June 16, 2010*
 3. Development Projects: Mohler distributed a 4-page (Community Development) listing of proposed and current projects in Cathedral City (Planners update monthly). Commission appreciated updates.

 1. Discuss pro/cons of possible Roundabouts & Traffic Circles in future CC roadways. Discussion deferred to next meeting when Commissioner Glowitz will provide a 2nd presentation update.
